

# **NORTHEAST MIAMI-DADE MAYORS' JOINT TASK FORCE ON TRANSPORTATION**

## **RESOLUTION NO. R2006-01**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE NORTHEAST MIAMI-DADE MAYORS' JOINT TASK FORCE ON TRANSPORTATION AND SUPPORTING MUNICIPALITIES, SUPPORTING THE MIAMI-DADE COUNTY METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION (MPO) FUNDING, FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND MIAMI-DADE COUNTY'S AGGRESSIVE EFFORTS TO COMPLETE THE SOUTH FLORIDA EAST COAST CORRIDOR TRANSIT ANALYSIS STUDY AS RAPIDLY AS POSSIBLE.**

**WHEREAS**, mayors and representatives from numerous North Miami-Dade cities, towns and villages in Miami-Dade County, as well as County transportation officials, have joined together to form a joint task force to address regional transportation issues; and

**WHEREAS**, several workshops held by the Northeast Miami-Dade Mayors' Joint Task Force on Transportation ("Task Force") have produced proposed solutions and areas needing further discussion regarding many mutual problems and concerns; and

**WHEREAS**, the Task Force, strongly supports the Miami-Dade County Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) funding for the South Florida East Coast Corridor Transit Analysis Study, a 24 month study initiated in September 2005 to analyze the feasibility of rapid transit along the Florida East Coast Railroad corridor from Downtown Miami to Jupiter with stations located within the Northeast Miami-Dade Corridor.

**NOW, THEREFORE,**

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Northeast Miami-Dade Mayors' Joint Task Force

**Section 1.** The Northeast Miami-Dade Mayors' Joint Task Force on Transportation hereby supports and encourages MPO funding, Florida Department of Transportation and Miami-Dade County's aggressive efforts on completing the South Florida East Coast Corridor Transit Analysis Study as quickly as possible.

**Section 2.** The Northeast Miami-Dade Mayors' Joint Task Force formally request that Florida Department of Transportation complete the South Florida East Coast Corridor Analysis Study by no later than July of 2006 in an effort to implement a rapid transit system, if beneficial,
